

Data Collection and Assessment Skills:

- Provides a thorough and appropriate H & P
- Is organized and succinct in case presentations
- Is able to synthesize data & generate appropriate assessments and differential diagnoses
- Incorporated patient assessments into verbal and written work
- Writes appropriate chart notes in a timely fashion
- Monitors therapeutic plans
- Is able to apply medical knowledge in a clinical setting
- Exhibits facility with technical skills
- Exhibits appropriate communication skills with patients

Professional Behavior

(Note if student is engaged in behaviors that are listed.)

Competence: Learning & Knowledge

- Difficulty acknowledging or accepting feedback
- Problems with being prepared and/or participating in discussion
- Difficulty with recognizing limitations and/or calling upon assistance of others when needed

Respect for Others

- Occasions of lack of civility towards students, faculty, or staff
- Lapses in respecting patient confidentiality
- Occasions of sexist, racist, or sexual orientation comments harmful to professional relationships

Professional Responsibility

- Occasions of arriving late without notifying appropriate individuals
- Occasions of being unavailable for required clinical responsibilities
- Difficulty in meeting deadlines or following through in a sufficiently timely manner
- Difficulty working effectively in team-oriented patient care

Compassion

- Problems with or lapses in addressing the possible fear & suffering of patients and their families

Social Responsibility

- Lapses in considering the social factors that threaten the health of patients
